One Maths and English task should be completed One Maths, English and Phonics task should be completed every day. Please also ensure your child reads every day. You can choose a subject in the **purple** section for the afternoons.

Mathematics (1 x 60 minutes)	<p>Maths lessons can be found on Google Classroom and will mirror the maths being covered in the classroom at that time. This may be a combination of White Rose maths videos (the scheme we use in school), the screens shared in the classroom and resources/worksheets.
