I wish you a happy weekend and don't forget the ice creams! It is going to be a hot one!

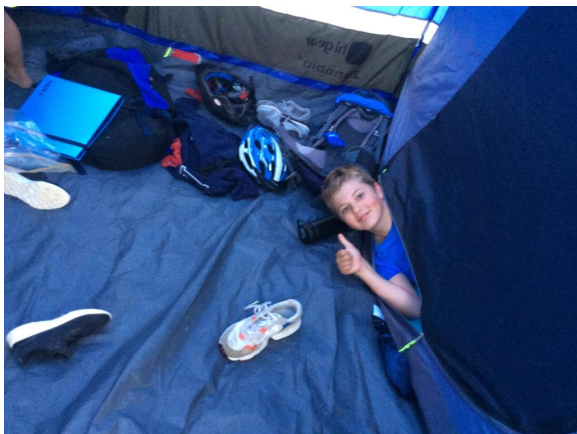
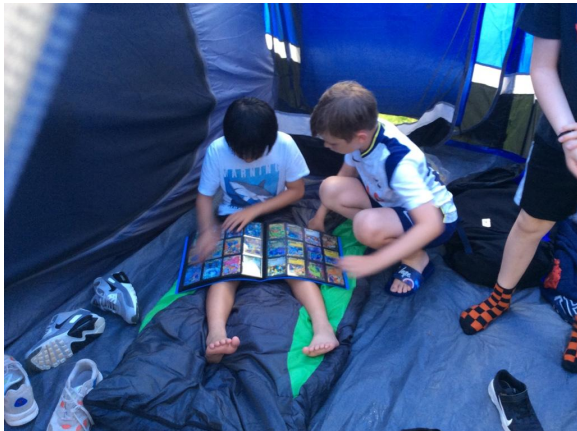

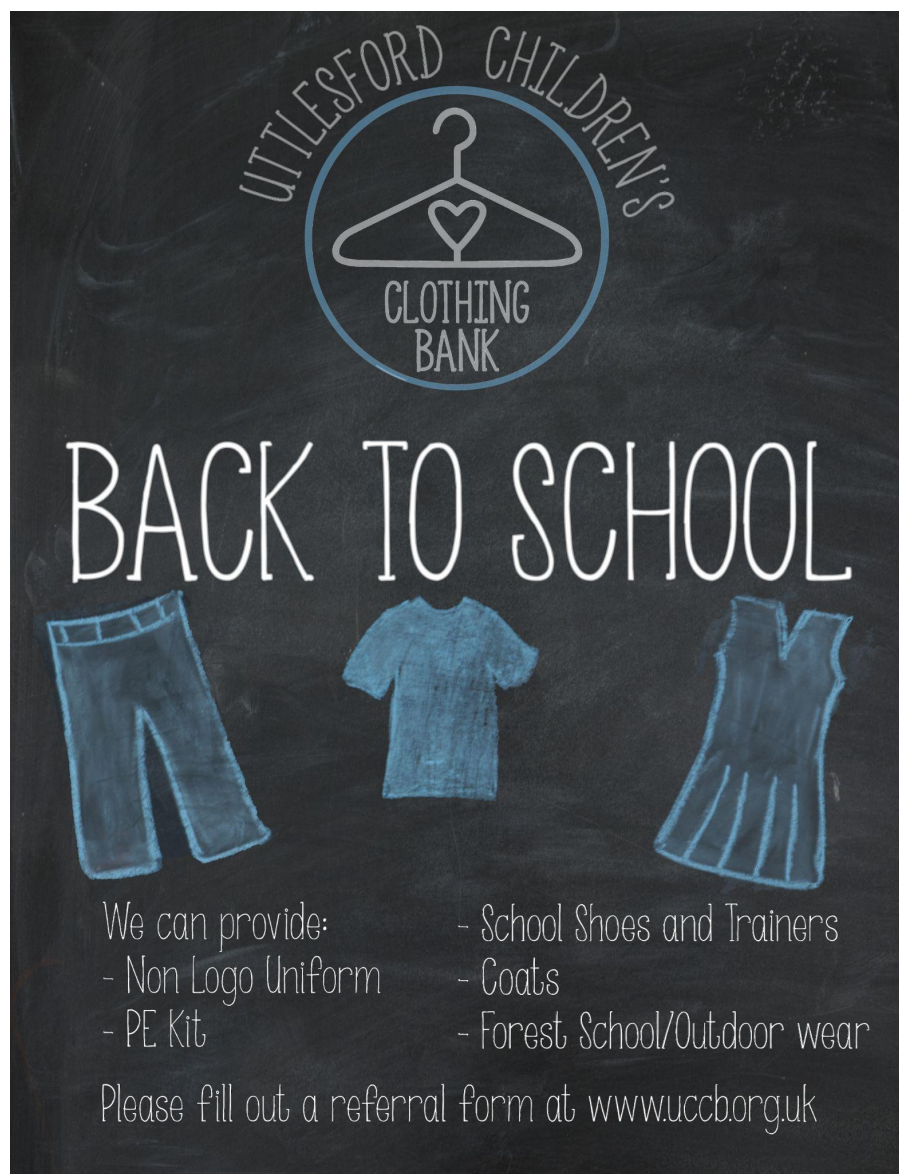
