<p>Mathematics</p> <p>(1 x 60 minutes)</p>	<p>Maths lessons can be found on Google Classroom and will mirror the maths being covered in the classroom at that time. This may be a combination of White Rose maths videos (the scheme we use in school), the screens shared in the classroom and resources/worksheets. Complete one lesson per day and then use the answer sheet to check your work.</p> <p>CHALLENGE: If you feel you can work on a harder challenge afterwards, use the Maths 'Challenge Template' and try some of the activities.</p>
<p>Phonics</p> <p>(1 x 15 minutes)</p>	<p>Please choose one of the websites below for an activity each day:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Log in to phonics play https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk using the username and password (Username: march20, Password: home). Select an activity to play linked to the sound your child is on (see below). There are lots of different activities to choose from. Please try and vary the activities over the week to ensure that children are practising different skills (sound recognition, segmenting, blending and tricky word recognition). 2) Log in to https://wandleenglishhub.org.uk/lettersandsounds/reception. Watch the video and answer the questions that are asked. Please note that this will redirect to a government-funded YouTube video. <p>The sounds you will be working on are as follows for this week: galaxies - Phase 2 - s, a, t, p, i, n. rockets - phase 3 - st, nd stars - Phase 5 - ay, ou (Stickers have been placed at the front of your child's reading record indicating their spelling/phonics group).</p>
