



Re: Remote Learning – awaiting COVID-19 test results

We would firstly like to thank you for your support with following the government guidelines and keeping your child at home if they are displaying any COVID-19 symptoms. This is ensuring that our whole school community is mitigating the risk of the transmission of COVID-19, which means the Academy can continue to run as efficiently as possible.

We understand that it is taking a while to access COVID-19 testing and receiving the test results and we thank you for your patience with this. In the event that your child's symptoms start to ease and they are well enough to 'work' but they are not permitted to attend the Academy because they are still awaiting COVID-19 test results, we have put together some home learning activities from various areas of the curriculum to complete.

One Maths and English task should be completed every day. One other subject must be completed each day - you can choose this subject from the **purple** section. Please ensure your child completes a minimum of 2-3 SPAG tasks a week and reads a book every day.

Mathematics (1 x 60 minutes)	10-15 min Daily practice of times tables at https://play.ttrockstars.com/ Maths lessons can be found on Google Classroom and will mirror the maths being covered in the classroom at that time. This may be a combination of White Rose maths videos (the scheme we use in school), the screens shared in the classroom and resources/worksheets. Complete one lesson per day and then use the answer sheet to check your work. CHALLENGE: If you feel you can work on a harder challenge afterwards, use the Maths 'Challenge Template' and try some of the activities.
