In the event that your child needs to self-isolate but is well enough to 'work', this home learning letter provides your child with learning activities from various areas of the curriculum to complete at home. Each area of learning will have a link, which you can use to access the work. You may need to copy and paste the link.

One Maths and English task should be completed every day. One other subject must be completed each day - you can choose this subject from the **purple** section. Please ensure your child completes a minimum of 2-3 SPAG tasks a week and reads a book every day.

Mathematics (1 x 60 minutes)	10-15 min Daily practice of times tables at https://play.ttrockstars.com/ Maths lessons can be found on Google Classroom and will mirror the maths being covered in the classroom at that time. This may be a combination of White Rose maths videos (the scheme we use in school), the screens shared in the classroom and resources/worksheets. Complete one lesson per day and then use the answer sheet to check your work. CHALLENGE: If you feel you can work on a harder challenge afterwards, use the Maths 'Challenge Template' and try some of the activities.
